Ana Margarida Bandeira is President of the Directive Council of the Portuguese Institute of Industrial Property (INPI PT) since February 2019. She holds a degree in Chemical Engineering (Technical University of Lisbon) and has a High-Level Course on Public Administration Management (National Institute of Administration) and the Advanced Course in Public Management CAGEP (ISCTE-IUL).



She is the head of the Portuguese Institute in the meetings of the Board of Directors of the European Patent Organization (EPO) and in the European Union Intellectual Property Office (EUIPO), as well as in the General Assemblies of the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) and in the European Observatory on Infringements of Intellectual Property Rights.

With more than 30 years of professional experience in the field of industrial property, Ana started her activity in 1989 as a patent examiner and held, at the same institution, several management and leadership positions, such as Director of Trademarks and Patents, Head of the Department of Patents and Utility Models and Head of the Department of Industrial Designs and Models.

Ana Bandeira along her professional career, assumed the coordination of the activities of the Portuguese Anti-Counterfeiting Group (GAC) in the scope of the IPRs Enforcement. Has represented the Portuguese Office in many conferences, meetings and seminars both in Portugal and abroad.

As a delegate and appointed expert participated in many international IP events related to Patent Law, Quality System of Patents, Trademarks, Appellations of Origin and Geographical Indications. These events were organized by several International Organizations such as the World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO), European Patent Office (EPO), European Commission and European Council, EU Observatory on the Infringement of Intellectual Property Rights and the Intergovernmental Committee of the Ibero-American Countries (IBEPI).

She has authored several professional articles in the field of industrial property and in 2019 appointed President of the Advisory Council of DNS.PT Association.
