According to the prosecutor, Martti Enäjärvi, the former director general of the National Board of Patents and Registration (NBPR), has used state credit and payment time cards for his own private expenses.

The matter has been heard in the Helsinki District Court in October and a court decision is expected in December.

Enäjärvi has often withdrawn cash from the Kaisaniemenkatu and Mikonkatu vending machines in the immediate vicinity of the Casino several times during the same day.
