Minister of Justice Elvinas Jankevičius as of March 20 appointed the current head of the State Patent Bureau Arūnas Želvis for a second five-year term.

The current manager actively contributed to the implementation of the trademark reform - the drafting and implementation of the new Trademark Law, which meets the new requirements of the European Union law.

A.Želvys, who has a law degree, has been managing the State Patent Bureau since 2015, having previously worked as the Head of the Legal and International Affairs Division of this institution, Attaché for Justice for Industrial Property and Civil Law at the Permanent Representation of Lithuania to the European Union.

The State Patent Bureau carries out the state legalization of the protection of industrial property objects (inventions, designs, trademarks and topographies of semiconductor products) in Lithuania and the functions of the central industrial property office in the European Union and the European Patent Organization.
