Call for directors of the Intellectual Property Office

Ljubljana, 27 June (STA) - The Ministry of Economic Development and Technology has announced a public competition for the position of director of the Slovenian Intellectual Property Office. Vojko Toman has been in charge of this since mid-September last year. Interested candidates can apply until July 12.

According to the call published on the website of the Ministry of Public Administration, the selected candidate will be appointed for a term of five years with the possibility of reappointment.

Candidates must, among other things, have a university or higher professional education with a specialization or a master's degree or. education obtained in a second-cycle study program in accordance with the law governing higher education and at least seven years of work experience.

They must have a basic level of English and German, a higher level of English or German and a higher level of French .

Applicants must also submit a vision of the priorities and development of the organizational unit or body over a five-year term.

A special competition committee appointed by the Council of Officials will determine which candidates are eligible for the position and which candidates are suitable for the position according to their professional qualifications.
